## Temporary District Facilities

The Board recognizes the need to provide classrooms and other needed spaces which are safe and well designed for the effective delivery of instruction and related services. The Board's aim is to have sufficient permanent facilities to meet the needs of school enrollment and the school program. Rented facilities, movable units and other emergency school housing may be inadequate for long-term public school purposes.

When additional facilities are needed and financing and circumstances do not allow for permanent construction, the Board will examine all options available to provide the needed spaces which will assure that the primary task of educating the youth of Lincoln County will continue in an orderly and timely manner. Facilities may be leased or moveable structures may be used as a temporary measure.

The Board encourages the involvement of staff, parents and the community in the decision-making process, whenever possible. The superintendent will give due consideration to all such input in his/her recommendations to the Board. All final decisions regarding the use of temporary district facilities will be made by the Board.

Any such facility must conform to all appropriate federal, state and local building and land use codes, health and fire laws, environmental standards and provisions for accessibility and usability as required by the Americans with Disabilities Act.
