

Student Fund-Raising Activities

All All fund raising must be approved by the building administrator and supervised by the appropriate advisor. Fund-raising projects involving the sale of products must also be approved by the activity sponsor and by the building administrator before the activity is initiated. Solicitation of funds is expressly prohibited without the building administrator's consent.

In order to not overburden the community, the superintendent or designee will develop administrative regulations to coordinate fund-raising activities throughout the district.

If fund raising consists of selling food and beverage items to students during the regular or extended school day, the food and beverage items must comply with state and federal nutrition standards, rules and laws. This does not apply to food and beverage items sold at school-related or nonschool-related events for which parents and other adults are a significant part of the audience.
