Public Art

The district believes that public art, when consciously created and responsibly maintained, is a valuable and integral part of school history and culture. From the moment of their creation, public art pieces offer educational opportunities across disciplines and help students forge relationships with their school surroundings. Over time, a piece of public art can connect alumni and the community at large to the well-being and health of their neighborhood schools.

This policy pertains to works of two- and three-dimensional art, in any medium, that was planned and executed with the intention of display, accessible to all, indoors or outdoors, on district grounds.

The superintendent or designee shall develop administrative regulations to implement the intent of this policy.
