

## **Interdistrict Transfer Agreement**

Under the authority of ORS 339.125 and the policies adopted by the Board of each participating school district, Grant County, Oregon, the districts agree as follows:

1. The attending district shall admit students who are residents of the resident district and provide them the same instruction and services as are provided by attending district to its own resident students.
2. Students will be admitted at the discretion of the admitting district, on a case by case consideration, under the following conditions:
  - a. Classroom space must be available, in the opinion or within the guidelines on class size of the attending district;
  - b. Any other conditions which are in the best interest of the attending district.
3. In partial consideration for services supplied its resident students by the attending district, the resident district stands ready to admit similarly situated residents of the attending district, on the same terms and conditions as those set out in this agreement.
4. It is understood that upon approval, the resident district shall release said students to the attending district. The attending district shall claim these students as resident students for the purposes of claiming basic school support.
5. No funds shall be exchanged between the districts. The attending district shall report the students as resident students as per ORS 339.133.
6. Special education students are generally high cost students. If a student's needs are fully met by the ESD or regional program personnel or equipment, no charge beyond that charged for regular education students will be made. Any students on an individual education plan (IEP) are considered part of the special education program. Resident district may recall students placed on an IEP or students who have had significant change in an IEP while in the attending district to the resident district at any time within the year. As such, if the cost of providing such services exceeds the payment from the state school fund, the attending district will bill the resident district for the additional cost.
7. This agreement does not include transportation of said students.

8. This agreement must be reviewed and approved annually, prior to June 30th, by each district's Board.
9. This agreement shall be valid for the entire school year for which it was approved.

**Requests for Interdistrict Transfer** (Requiring the consent of only the attending district)

A student who resides within district boundaries may make a request to attend school in another district that agrees to accept the student. The agreement will be by written consent of the attending district only whereby the student becomes a "resident student" of the attending district, allowing the attending district to receive State School Funding. The student who resides within the district must complete the application process in the district in which the student wishes to attend.
