Closed Campus**

Students shall not leave the campus without a legitimate reason once they have arrived on the school grounds. A legitimate reason is to be established under the supervision of the superintendent, together with the student and his/her parents. Written permission from the student's parents is required.

High school students may leave the campus at noon time, subject to the following rules and regulations:

1. Permission slips shall be signed at the beginning of each school year, by both parents and/or guardians, and placed on file with the administration;
2. Parental permission, in writing, shall exempt the district from all liability during the period of absence from the campus;
3. This privilege is granted to students in good standing as determined by the superintendent. Ineligible students may not leave the campus regardless of permission from parents;
4. For good and sufficient reason, the superintendent may revoke the off-campus privilege for any and all students. The reinstatement of privileges will be granted at the discretion of the superintendent;
5. Students are not to be in their vehicles from the time they arrive at school until the end of the school day.
