Relations with Home-Schooled Students**

The district recognizes that some parents may wish to educate their students at home and acknowledges the Education Service District's role in registering and in receiving testing information for students who are being taught at home.

The Board chooses not to grant high school credit for home schooling nor to award diplomas to home-schooled students who reside within the district. Students enrolled in a district mentorship shall receive credit. Parents who elect to school their students at home are encouraged to pursue GED or community college diplomas.

Home-schooled students may enroll in elective classes in which there is room.

Home-schooled students may participate in on site Special Education and related services as defined in the law.

Home-schooled students may participate in interscholastic activities in the school serving their attendance area if:

1. They are in compliance with all rules governing home schooling.
2. They meet all district eligibility criteria, except school or class attendance requirements and class requirements of the OSAA.
3. They achieve a minimum score on the annual achievement test required of all home school students (students may participate while awaiting test results).
4. They fulfill the same responsibilities and standards of behavior and performance including practice requirements of other students participating in the interscholastic activity.
5. The student complies with all public school requirements during the time of participation.
