

Class Rank

Class rank based on grade point averages and weighted rank order will be determined at the end of a student's junior year and at the end of the seventh semester.

Adjustment of grade point averages shall be used for establishing a weighted class rank.

A weighted rank order will be calculated to recognize the intellectual rigor inherent in certain classes: All advanced placement and honors courses offered by the district shall be known as "weighted" courses. In addition, Pre-calculus, Calculus I, Calculus II, and 4th/5th year language courses shall be known as "weighted" courses.

A weighted rank order will be determined by adding the student's GPA times six with the number of weighted classes and total number of earned credits. The formula for determining weighted class rank shall be: $W + 6 \text{ GPA} + \text{EC} = [\# \text{ of weighted classes} + 6 (\text{GPA}) + \text{total earned credit}]$

W = Weighted semester courses (e.g., Sophomore Honors English = 2)

GPA = Cumulative grade point average

EC = Earned semester credits (the total semester credits that a student passed)
