Equal Educational Opportunity

Equal educational opportunity and treatment shall be provided all students. No student enrolled in the district shall, on the basis of race, color, religion, sex, sexual orientation¹, national origin, marital status, age, or disability be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any educational program or activity provided or authorized by the district.

The district staff shall make a continuous effort to eliminate those conditions which may cause discrimination.

The superintendent will designate at least one employee to coordinate its efforts to comply with and carry out its responsibilities under Title IX. The Title IX coordinator will investigate complaints communicated to the district alleging noncompliance with Title IX. The name, address and telephone number will be provided to all students and employees.

Complaints concerning possible violation of equal educational opportunity will be processed according to the appeals procedure described in Board Policy KL - Public Complaints.
