Student Safety

It is the responsibility of the district to provide a safe and secure environment for students while they are in school or under the supervision of school authorities. Not only does this responsibility include maintaining buildings, grounds and equipment to meet the full intent of Oregon Administrative Rules, but it also includes protecting students, insofar as is possible, from external influences on or about the campuses or in any other area where students are engaged in supervised, school-sponsored activities.

Safety instruction will precede the use of materials and equipment by students in applicable units of work. Staff will teach and enforce all established safety rules. Rules will include, but not be limited to, wearing protective eye devices in appropriate activities.

Students may be asked to sign off upon completion of reading safety policies and materials and upon the completion of safety instruction

Among actions taken to meet this responsibility, the superintendent shall name a safety officer for the district and define the duties of the position, shall create procedures to implement this policy, and shall establish staff education and public information programs about the policy.
