Cocurricular/Extracurricular Activities

Curricular

Activities such as field trips, intramural sports field days, etc., shall be considered a required part of the school curriculum provided they have been properly scheduled and approved by the administration.

Extra-Curricular

Extra-Curricular activities are those which are sponsored by the school or the student body, but which take place outside the regular school day or school program. These activities are considered to be an essential part of the educational program of the district, but participation is not required of students.

All activities must conform to the general educational program of the district and shall be under the direct supervision of certificated staff and/or the principal. No one is to attend unless regularly enrolled in school or by special invitation.

Extra-Curricular Guest Procedure

Each eligible student shall be permitted to bring one guest to an approved class, club, student body, school or district-sponsored extra-curricular activity provided:

1. The student files a completed guest permission slip in the school office at least one day prior to the activity.
2. The guest is within the age span of the students involved in the activity.
3. The guest agrees to submit to the rules by which district students are governed.
4. Junior High School students may not be guests at High School activities.
