

Transportation Procedures

1. School buses will not typically be operated on private property.
2. Special transportation for disabled students shall be determined on an individual basis by the student's individualized education plan (IEP).
3. School bus loading and unloading on district property shall be supervised by school staff under the direction of each principal.
4. Each student passenger must have a seat that fully supports each student.
5. Transported students shall receive instruction at the start of the school year and at midyear as required by law. This shall include two evacuation drills.
6. Nonstudents may not ride school buses unless expressly authorized to do so.
7. Nontransported students shall, early in the year, receive instruction as required by law.
8. Accident reports will be filed as required by law.

The district will pay for two round trips daily between a student's home and the end of the bus route when the district is unable to provide complete service.

1. Travel is for public road miles only.
2. Payment will be for days attending school only.
3. Mileage allowance will be at the current IRS rate.
4. Payment will be limited to one payment per family.
5. One mile one way is the requirement before any mileage in lieu will be paid.
6. Payment will be monthly after application has been made and the Board has approved.

Paid drivers will not be furnished for operation of district cars or vans except for approved regular routes.
