

Participation Regulations

Eligibility for All Junior-Senior High School Extracurricular Activities

Students must be enrolled in and passing all classes of an approved graduation schedule in order to participate in extracurricular activities.

Classroom Academic Achievement

1. Starting at the end of the second week of each nine-week grading period, staff members will, each Monday, submit failing notices which will reflect accumulative grades.
2. A list of failing students shall be compiled on the following Monday and given to all secondary teachers. The list shall consist of two columns entitled “probation” and “ineligible.”
3. Students whose names are submitted for the first time in a particular class will be listed in the probations column. Students listed in the column will be allowed full privileges in extracurricular participation.
4. Students who are receiving failing grades for two or more consecutive weeks in the same class will be listed in the ineligible columns. The student will be declared ineligible for extracurricular activities until the next failing list is published and the student is receiving passing grades in the particular class. The ineligible student shall not compete during the week of ineligibility but will be allowed to practice.
5. Eligibility rules will not be used as a lever in cases of discipline.
6. The principal is authorized, within OSAA requirements, to authorize eligibility for special education students and emergency situations for physical and other disabilities.
