

Student Behavior Expectations

1. Students are required to conform to school rules and regulations and to Oregon law.
2. Student disrespect, impudence and disobedience is not to be tolerated by school staff.
3. Truancy and tardiness are in violation of statute as well as school regulations.
4. Bus students shall comply with district regulations and shall comply with the reasonable directives of the bus driver.
5. Students are under jurisdiction and control of school authorities at school parties, games and all activities, and while being transported by the district. School rules and regulations shall remain in force at all times.
6. Teachers, principals and other licensed or deputized employees may make and file in the proper court a criminal complaint against any adult student.
7. Teachers, principals and other licensed or deputized employees may make and file in the juvenile court a complaint against any minor student.
8. Each principal shall prepare a list of school rules and regulations for students. This shall be made known to the students and to the staff. A copy of those rules shall be filed with the superintendent.
9. Teachers may establish additional rules and regulations. These shall be in written form by the teacher and approved by the principal. After approval, they shall be made known to the students.
10. Principals and teachers shall supervise the discipline of students at all school activities and functions.
