## **Prohibited Use, Possession, Distribution or Sale of Tobacco Products and Inhalant Delivery Systems**

The use, distribution or sale of tobacco products or inhalant delivery systems is not permitted at any time, including non-school hours in the following areas:

1. Any building, facility, or vehicle owned, leased, rented or chartered by the district;
2. Any school grounds, athletic grounds, or parking lots; or
3. At any school-sponsored events on or off district property.

Tobacco products is defined to include, but not limited to, any lighted or unlighted cigarette, cigar, pipe, bidi, clove cigarette and any other smoking product, and spit tobacco, also known as smokeless, dip, chew or snuff in any form. Use of tobacco is defined as smoking, inhaling, dipping or chewing tobacco products.

For the purpose of this policy, “inhalant delivery systems” means a device that can be used to deliver nicotine and cannabinoids in the form of a vapor or aerosol to a person inhaling from the device; or a component of a device or a substance in any form sold for the purpose of being vaporized or aerosolized by a device, whether the component or substance is sold or not sold separately.

Tobacco and inhalant delivery systems promotional items, which include book covers, books, and other school-related materials, will not be used to supplement current curriculum in grades 1-12. Tobacco and inhalant delivery systems advertising is prohibited in all school-sponsored publications, in school building, and at all school-sponsored events.

The district encourages linkages to tobacco cessation resources for students, staff, family members and visitors through the Yamhill County Public Health Department and other health care providers.
