School Superintendent

The superintendent is the chief executive officer of the school system and has, under the direction of the Board of Education, general supervision of all the schools and of all the personnel of the school system. The superintendent is responsible for management of the schools under the Board's policies, and is accountable to the Board of Education.

The superintendent may delegate to other school personnel the exercise of any powers and the discharge of any duties imposed upon the Superintendent by these policies or by vote of the Board of Education. The delegation of power or duty, however, will not relieve the superintendent of responsibility for the action taken under such delegation.

The superintendent shall advise the Board of Education on the manner in which official Board policy or other Board decisions have been implemented by the superintendent and staff.
