

Management of Buildings and Grounds

The superintendent will develop and maintain plans and procedures necessary to assure the security of district properties and to provide for a continuing program of preventive maintenance designed to insure that building are clean, safe and operated in an efficient manner. The business manager, subject to the direction of the superintendent, will have overall responsibility for the maintenance and security of the district's buildings and grounds.

The superintendent will keep the Board informed about district properties and will make such other reports as the Board requests.
