Curriculum Development

The Board of Education recognizes a need for a systematic ongoing program of curriculum development and improvement. The Board of Education expects the administration and staff to use the adopted curriculum renewal procedures to investigate new curriculum, and to recommend modification of current programs and practices, changes in curriculum content, and addition of new courses and offerings within each instructional program. The education division shall be responsible for coordinating the development of district curricular guidelines for new instructional programs and classes.

Teachers shall participate in curriculum development as a regular part of their teaching responsibilities.

The superintendent, in cooperation with the curriculum department of the education division and other appropriate staff, shall make curriculum recommendations to the Board of Education for their consideration and adoption.

The superintendent and administration shall make regular reports to the Board of Education on items concerning curriculum.
