

Student Attendance Boundary Verification of Residency and Home Visit Procedures

In circumstances where a family's residency must be verified by the district, Medford staff will require the family to submit document to verify residence. Examples of acceptable documentation may include, but are not limited to, the following:

1. Driver's license showing current address.
2. Property tax statements.
3. Mortgage statement or other loan documentation.
4. Rental agreement or lease agreement.
5. Utility bills.
6. A signed and sworn affidavit or declaration stating that the family has moved to the residence with the intent to live there indefinitely and to terminate all occupancy of the previous residence.

Families who believe they may qualify for services to homeless families based on the McKinney-Vento Act Homeless Education Assistance Improvement Act, please see school Board policy JECBD.
