Student Representatives to the Board of Education

The Board of Education provides for a formalized, on-going method of communication with the students of Medford Schools by establishing two positions of student representatives to the Board of Education.

There shall be one high school student representative to the Board of Education from each high school. Student representatives shall be appointed by the building principals. The term of office for these positions shall be from September 1 to June 1.

The student representatives shall receive notice of meetings, the agenda, and the appropriate non-confidential agenda materials; be provided chairs and name plates at the Board of Education table; and shall have the same privileges of discussion as apply to members of the Board of Education. The student representatives shall not be voting members of the Board of Education.

The student representatives shall not participate in executive sessions of the Board of Education. Exceptions to this rule may be granted by the Board of Education Chairman.
