

Damage to School Property by Students

Teachers and principals are held responsible for the preservation and protection of school district property against unnecessary damage. When property is willfully or negligently damaged or destroyed, it is charged to the pupil or individual perpetrating the act.

When, in the judgment of the principal, the damage or destruction is not willful but accidental, the district may absorb or share the cost of the repair on such a basis as principal and superintendent may determine.

Any marks, cuts, etc., on furnishings or other parts of the room or building are to be reported to the principal immediately.
