

Vehicles – Motorized and Nonmotorized

1. Condition Description

School traffic and parking regulations are necessary due to parking limitations and dangerous traffic patterns. The school parking lot is available to students and is under the supervision of the school during the regular school day.

2. Guidelines

a. Right

- (1) Any licensed driver may drive a vehicle onto the school premises in authorized areas.

b. Responsibilities

- (1) Student motor vehicles must be registered with the school administration.
- (2) Student vehicles will be permitted to leave the school grounds during school hours only with the permission of the school administration.
- (3) School rules and local and state traffic laws must be followed at all times.
- (4) Students may only park in those areas designated for student parking.
- (5) Bicycles and other non-motorized vehicles must also be parked in designated areas.
- (6) Parking and driving regulations will be enforced by towing the vehicle at the owner's or operator's expense or by student fines.
