

Loitering on School Grounds

Condition Description

To help protect student and school property and to prevent disruptive activity, school officials must be aware of persons on the school premises who are not members of the staff or student body.

Guidelines

1. Right

Visitors are permitted on school premises if their presence is approved by school officials.

2. Responsibilities

- a. Visitors must come to the school office to receive permission to visit school.
- b. No individual may loiter on school grounds or in the buildings. Loitering means
- c. not having any reason or relationship involving custody of or responsibility for a student or, upon inquiry, not having a specific, legitimate reason for being there.
- d. All staff members and employees of each school are empowered by the district
- e. to order any person not a District 549C student, employee, Board Member, or person authorized to be on the school premises to leave said premises and to make the individual or individuals aware that failure to comply with this order to leave the premises is trespassing.
