## **Physical Examinations of Students\*\***

Medford School District requires students who participate in extracurricular sports in grades 7 through 12 to have a physical examination prior to participation. A person conducting the physical examination shall use a form and protocol prescribed by the State Board of Education.

The school district requires students who continue to participate in extracurricular sports in grades 7 through 12 to have a physical examination once every two years.

Students who are diagnosed with a significant illness or have had a major surgery will have a physical examination prior to further participation in extracurricular sports.

Any physical examination shall be conducted by a physician possessing an unrestricted license to practice medicine, a licensed physician assistant, a certified nurse practitioner, or a licensed chiropractic physician who has clinical training and experience in detecting cardiopulmonary diseases and defects.

The physical examination is the responsibility of the parents/students and is to be paid by them. Record of the exam shall be kept on file at school and shall be reviewed by the coach prior to the start of any sport season. Students shall not participate without a record of passing the examination.
