## Home Schooling

The Board of Medford School District 549C acknowledges the rights of parents to use home instruction as an alternative to school enrollment.

Further, the Board is willing to assist parents in this endeavor if a request is made through the superintendent. The district will, upon request, furnish course descriptions and state minimum standards for elementary or secondary education, and, when available, may provide textbooks with a loss/damage fee.

The Board recognizes the benefit for some home schooled students to participate in the public school program. Opportunity for part-time enrollment will be extended to home-schooled student residing within the boundaries of the district.

The Board exercises its prerogative not to accept home instruction course credit toward graduation requirements.

Home schooled students may participate in interscholastic activities provided they meet the criteria specified in Policy IGD.
