Consultants to the Board

The Board may engage persons in an advisory capacity when specific services are required that are beyond the capabilities or responsibilities of regularly employed personnel.

Consultants may include attorneys, auditors, architects, agents of record and others with technical skills or professional training.

The Board may select consultants to serve for a specified period of time or may engage consultants to perform specific tasks on a temporary basis. Except where the consultant serves under a written contract for a specified period of time, the Board has sole discretion for terminating such advisory services.

The Board shall conduct periodic reviews of the services and may request periodic reports to the Board.

The Board shall follow MESD contracting and procurement policies and procedures when selecting consultants.
