Safety Program

Safe buildings, grounds and equipment shall be maintained in order to prevent accidents or injury to students, employees and other citizens from fire, natural disasters, mechanical and electrical malfunction and other hazards.

Buildings shall be planned, equipped and maintained in accordance with appropriate local, state and federal safety regulations.

Buildings shall be provided with alarm systems, fire extinguishers and other safety devices required by state and federal laws and regulations.

The Superintendent shall develop and implement a safety program which will include, but not be limited to, compliance with and enforcement of all state and federal laws, rules and regulations. Safety Program requirements/plan are found in Board Policy EBAC - MESD Safety Committee.
