Use of Automated External Defibrillator (AED)

MESD has established an AED program and stationed AED devices on premises for emergencies. The purpose of this program is to provide trained MESD employees with prompt access to AED devices in the event of a sudden cardiac arrest emergency.

As part of this program, MESD is required to have a Medical Director (MD) who has the ongoing responsibility for:

1. Providing a written prescription for the AED device(s), to be kept on file in the office of School Health Services;
2. All medical control aspects;
3. Reviewing and approving guidelines for emergency procedures related to use of AEDs and CPR/AED training programs; and
4. Overseeing the quality review and improvement plans.

The superintendent or designee will develop and maintain a plan for training and use of AEDs.
