Resource and Energy Conservation

MESD will make a concerted effort to conserve its resources. An act of good citizenship is the conservation of natural resources and energy.

MESD encourages and supports an energy conservation and education program to lower substantially the consumption of electricity, natural gas, gasoline and water. It will be the responsibility of each MESD employee and student to participate in conservation efforts to reduce consumption to levels prescribed by state and federal guidelines while maintaining programs or to levels necessary to maintain programs, whichever is less. Therefore, staff and students will make resource conservation a part of MESD's physical operation and educational program.

It is the responsibility of MESD administrators, through the superintendent's office, to implement, direct, monitor, evaluate and report MESD energy conservation efforts.
