Student Transportation Services**

Transportation of students in MESD programs is, as a general rule, the responsibility of the student's resident district. The ESD may provide transportation for students enrolled in ESD programs when requested by the district. The extent of services shall be determined by contract.

District of MESD transportation shall be considered extensions of the school experience. All students using school transportation shall abide by the code of conduct which is posted in each school or activity vehicle. Violations of the code, as well as other conduct which is improper or which jeopardizes the safety of self or others, shall be reported by the school bus driver to the supervisor. The supervisor shall, as soon as possible, inform the appropriate principal of such occurrence. Violators may be denied use of transportation for a period of time as deemed proper by the principal or supervisor.

When transporting student field trips or MESD-sponsored functions, transportation must be approved by the program supervisor or superintendent. Aides or assistants who ride district or MESD provided transportation shall receive training on emergency procedures and their role in the safe transportation of all students.
