Board-Staff Communications

The Board desires to maintain open communication channels between itself and MESD staff. The line of communication shall be through the MESD superintendent.

This policy does not restrict protected labor relations communications of bargaining unit members.

Staff-to-Board Communications

Formal communications such as requests, invitations or reports to the Board or Board sub-committees shall be submitted through the superintendent for distribution to the Board or inclusion on a meeting agenda.

This procedure shall not be construed as denying the right of any employee to address the Board on matters of public concern at a regularly scheduled Board meeting as provided for in Board policy BDDH.

Board-to-Staff Communications

All official Board communications such as announcements, policies, and shall be communicated to staff through the superintendent.
