Credit for Proficiency

MESD programs may grant credit towards a diploma or modified diploma to students who demonstrate defined levels of proficiency or mastery of recognized standards, including knowledge and skills (state academic content standards and essential skills, industry-based or other national or international standards) by completing classroom equivalent work; passing an appropriate exam; passing an appropriate exam, providing a collection of work or other assessment evidence; documentation of prior learning activities or experiences, or to complete any combination of the above as approved by the MESD.

The Board directs the superintendent and cabinet to develop an administrative regulation that establishes criteria for granting proficiency credit.
