Detention of Students**

An administrator or teacher may detain a student for disciplinary reasons after school hours, provided the parent, guardian or person in a parental relationship has been notified of the detention and, in the case of bus students, the responsible district has been notified and arrangements have been made for the student's transportation home. In cases of suspected child abuse, students may be detained while waiting for a representative from Oregon Department of Human Services or law enforcement and the responsible district shall be notified.

Parents, guardians or persons in a parental relationship may be asked to arrange for the transportation of the detained student; however, if the parent, guardian or person in a parental relationship cannot or will not provide it, an alternative disciplinary procedure must be substituted.

Students who are detained after school shall not be left alone during their detention. Their supervision must be provided or arranged for by the teacher or administrator who detains them.
