Suspension**

The Board authorizes student suspension for one or more of the following reasons:

1. Willful violation of MESD regulations;
2. Willful conduct which materially and substantially disrupts the rights of others to an education;
3. Willful conduct which endangers the student or other students;
4. Willful conduct which endangers MESD property.

Parents, students and employees shall be notified by handbook, code of conduct or other document of the procedures to address behavior and the consequences of that behavior.

Each suspension shall include a statement of the reasons for suspension, the length of the suspension and a plan for readmission. The maximum length of a suspension shall not exceed seven calendar days. Every reasonable and prompt effort must be made to notify the parents, guardians or persons in a parental relationship of suspended students.

In emergency situations that are a result of risk to health and safety, the MESD may postpone the suspension notice process above until the emergency condition has passed.

Students who are suspended may not attend after-school activities and athletic events, be present on MESD property without a parent, guardian or person in a parental relationship, or participate in activities directed or sponsored by MESD.
