

Policy Implementation

The superintendent is responsible for implementing the Board's policies and interpreting them to staff, students and the public. Other administrators share in this responsibility.

Some board policies require administrative regulations. Whenever appropriate, the superintendent will develop these administrative regulations in consultation with principals, staff members and other persons and groups as appropriate, and will submit them to the Board.

Policies officially adopted by the Board and other administrative regulations formulated to implement adopted Board policies will be included in the Board's *Policy Manual*. Staff, student and parent handbooks will be used for disseminating policies and administrative regulations to persons directly affected by them.

Principals are authorized to establish rules and procedures for the staff and student bodies of their schools as long as these rules and procedures are consistent with board policies and administrative regulations established by the Board and superintendent.
