

### **Infection Control - HIV, AIDS, Hepatitis B**

The district shall use standard precautions at all times for infection control. Each person is therefore treated as though an HIV, AIDS<sup>1</sup> or Hepatitis B infection exists.

The district shall develop an exposure control plan that includes infection control procedures for staff and students.

Procedures for staff and students shall include annual in-services that includes correct procedures for cleaning up body fluid spills and for personal cleanup, appropriate disposal, immunization and personal hygiene; location and content of first-aid and clean-up kits in each school room and each school vehicle; correct procedures for cleaning up body fluid spills and for personal cleanup.
