Temporary District Facilities

Because rented facilities, and other emergency school housing may be inadequate for long-term public school purposes, it is the Board's aim to have sufficient permanent facilities to meet the needs of school enrollment and the school program.

If circumstances require immediate space not available in public school buildings, facilities will be rented and used as a temporary measure. Any such facility must conform to all appropriate state and local building and land use code, health and fire laws and environment standards.
