## Retirement of Facilities

When the Board determines a building may be inadequate for instructional purposes a Board sub-committee will be formed to investigate the problem and prepare a recommendation for board action.

The Board will invite the viewpoints of community residents and staff prior to a final decision on the disposition of any school district facility.
