Public Gifts to the Schools

Gifts which may serve to enhance and extend the work of the schools may be received by the district. All gifts with a value in excess of \$500 shall be presented to the Board for acknowledgment and acceptance. The district will encourage those who desire to make contributions to consider equipment or services that are not likely to duplicate items provided from public fund expenditures.

1. Tangible property contributed to the schools becomes the property of the district and is subject to the same controls and regulations that govern the use of other district-owned property. Donations of capital equipment made to a school by a parent club shall remain at that school unless a transfer is authorized by the club president. Property records maintained at each school shall identify capital equipment donated by parent clubs.
2. Contributions of property or services that may involve major costs for installation or maintenance, or initial or continuing financial commitments from school funds, will be presented by the superintendent for Board consideration prior to approval and acceptance.
3. Any groups planning to raise money for a gift to a school or the school system should first consult with the principal and superintendent regarding what gift(s) would be most appropriate.
4. Priority lists of needed and desirable equipment, supplies or services will be kept in each school.
