Food Services Management

The Board of Directors shall maintain administrative and supervisory control of the food services program by delegating responsibility to the administrator. Such delegation of management shall not be construed as abandonment of responsibility.

The district will participate in the National School Lunch Program in accordance with established guidelines.

Lunch sales and other revenues from the food service program will offset direct cost. Indirect costs and other expenses may be subsidized by the district.

Meal prices will be established annually by the Board. The district will participate in the free or reduced price lunch program.

The food services manager will prepare such reports and will keep such records as are required by the National School Lunch Program and state laws, and as requested by the Board.

The superintendent will report to the Board at least annually on the food service program or at other times by Board request.

The following persons may eat in the cafeteria. Meal prices are to be posted in the cafeteria.

1. Monument Students
2. Full-time Employees
3. Part-time Employees when at school at lunchtime on school business
4. Occasional guest of employees/students
