Work Experience

All high school students are expected to be enrolled in classes equal to the number of daily class periods, unless participating in an approved work experience, alternative program, or other educational endeavor. One of the classes may be a study hall if so approved by the superintendent.

Seniors in good academic standing with a cumulative 3.0 GPA or better may qualify for early dismissal during the regular school day so that they may work or pursue other educational endeavors. This privilege may be revoked for attendance, behavior or credit problems.

Select juniors may qualify for work privilege with parent and superintendent consent. To be considered, a junior must be passing six (6) or more classes, have a cumulative 3.0 GPA or better, meet behavior criteria, and have both superintendent and parent permission.

Any special education student, for whom an Individual Education Plan provides for work experience/training, may participate in on or off campus training. The training provided will be according to the student's written plan and will be developed and implemented under the supervision of the district.

The district may deny or revoke this privilege if the student fails to meet any eligibility requirement.
