Grading System

The grading system is fully explained on the report cards and all grades should be marked as directed on the card. It is the responsibility of each teacher to be prepared to explain or justify any grade given, upon request of parents. Accurate recording of grades will facilitate explanation to parents.

Grades K – 4 will utilize E, S, N in reporting grades.

Grades 5 – 12 will utilize A, B, C, F in reporting grades except dual or concurrent enrollment classes shall be graded as requested by the student as either Pass/Fail or A, B, C, F. Dual or concurrent enrollment requests for Pass/Fail or letter grade must be made immediately upon the end of the term.
