Promotion and Retention of Students

Upon a request for promotion from a parent/guardian, the teaching staff shall hold a staffing and using the criteria adopted by the Board shall make a written recommendation to the administration.

Test results may be used to help determine the student's potential ability and actual performance. Test results, however, should not be the sole determining factor in evaluating the academic criteria.

A student must meet the academic area criteria before the other areas (social, chronological, physical, timing, knowledge) can be considered. Even if a student meets the criteria in the academic area, the student must qualify in all the other areas.

The superintendent shall review the staff's recommendation and meet with them to develop a final recommendation.

The decision shall be given in writing to the parent(s).

The parent(s) may appeal this decision to the Board at the next regular Board meeting.
