Assembly of Students

Conditions

1. It is important to the orderly use of school facilities that the use of all space be planned in advance.
2. Students, faculty, and administration are all responsible for the activities that are conducted in a school. The school is held accountable to a public, a school Board, and a legislature that gives fiscal support, accountable for the image of the school, and accountable to each other.
3. "Assembly" in this context refers to clubs, classes, or other meetings requested by students or their advisors.

Rights

Students shall be able to hold meetings on school property under the following conditions of responsibility:

Responsibilities

1. The meeting shall be scheduled two weeks in advance and must be approved by the Superintendent or his representative.
2. Meeting (or party) plans must be submitted to the Superintendent or his representative.
3. The meetings or parties shall indicate no hazard to persons or property.
4. Any groups of students that wish meeting shall request meetings through the office and group advisors.
5. Meetings or party plans that do not meet these conditions may be cancelled.
