Hiring of Staff

The responsibility for all recommendations to the Board for hiring staff, both classified and licensed, rests with the superintendent.

Since the district has such wide variations of population, numbers of students, classroom sizes and available classrooms, as well as differing distances between buildings and communities, all of which must be considered when providing for staffing needs, the developing of a single standard plan for all schools is, therefore, not practical. For this reason, the superintendent is given wide latitude to consider all possible factors and all possible combinations of personnel in order to staff the district adequately.
