

## **Student Dress and Grooming\*\***

Responsibility for dress and grooming rests primarily with students and their parents. However, the district expects student dress and grooming to meet standards which ensure that the following conditions do not exist:

1. Disruption or interference with the classroom learning environment;
2. Threat to the health and/or safety of the student concerned or of other students.

Students who represent the school in a voluntary activity may be required to conform to dress and grooming standards and may be denied the opportunity to participate if those standards are not met. Building principals are required to ensure specific student dress and grooming rules are established at the school, consistent with Board policy, state and federal law. Such rules shall be communicated annually through the school's student/parent handbook.
