District Legal Status

The legal basis for education in the district is vested in the will of the people as expressed in the Constitution of the state of Oregon, the statutes pertaining to education, court interpretation of the validity of these laws and the powers implied in them.

Specifically, ORS 332.072 states, "All school districts are bodies corporate, and the district school board is authorized to transact all business coming within the jurisdiction of the district and to sue and be sued. Pursuant to law, district school boards have control of the district schools and are responsible for educating children residing in the district."

The official name of this district shall be Myrtle Point School District No. 41, Coos County, Oregon, herein after known as district; but for all purposes of business, except where the name is mandatory, the Myrtle Point Public Schools may be used as the business title of the district.

Type of School District

Myrtle Point Public Schools is an administrative school district formed in accordance with ORS 330.505 to 330.780. The district was reorganized in 1960 into seven zones, except in the city area two zones had a common boundary. With passage of a November 7, 1995, initiative petition, the seven zones were eliminated and all Board positions are now elected "at large." Myrtle Point Public Schools shall be operated and administered in accordance with the laws applicable to administrative school districts having less than 40,000 population.
