

Board-Superintendent Relationship

The superintendent will be the chief executive officer of the Board and will be responsible for the professional leadership and skill necessary to translate the will of the Board into administrative action.

The superintendent will be responsible for all aspects of school operation and for such duties and powers pertaining thereto as directed or delegated by the Board. The superintendent may delegate responsibility, and the authority necessary to discharge it, to other officials and develop such procedures and regulations as he/she considers necessary to ensure efficient operation of the district.

The Board expects that the superintendent is professionally able and possesses outstanding qualities of leadership, vision and administrative skill, and that the superintendent will implement all policies of the Board in good faith.

The superintendent can expect the Board will respect the superintendent's professional competence and extend to him/her full responsibility for implementation of Board policy decisions. In order that the superintendent may provide effective leadership, the Board will delegate to the superintendent those powers, which it considers advisable. The superintendent can expect the Board to support the superintendent's decisions and administration of the district.
