New Board members will be provided the opportunity and will be encouraged to attend the orientation for new board member programs sponsored by the Oregon School Boards Association.

All Board members are encouraged to participate in * school * Board and related workshops sponsored by local, state and national school and education associations.

Board members will be required to report back to the Board with materials of interest gathered at the various meetings and workshops.

The Board will provide a board member professional library for Board members consisting of the laws, policies, directives and publications of the Oregon Department of Education and Oregon School Boards Association, as well as other publications as may be considered pertinent by the Board.

The Board will pay for the necessary expenses of all Board members who attend meetings and conventions pertaining to district activities and the objectives of the Board. The Board will also pay for all publications in the Board's library.

The Board, on a case-by-case basis will determine and limit the numbers of Board members authorized to attend specific workshops and conventions where the expenses involved warrant such limitations.
