Board Legislative Program

The Board, as an agent of the state of Oregon, must operate within the bounds of state and federal law affecting public education. The Board, in order to meet its responsibilities to the residents and students of the community, must work vigorously for the passage of new laws designed to advance the cause of good schools and for the repeal or modification of existing laws that impede this cause. For this accomplishment, the Board will as part of its legislative program effort:

1. Ensure that local media representatives and legislators are invited to Board meetings and school activities;
2. Establish regularized contacts with their legislators both in-district and in Salem;
3. Follow through with OSBA solicitations for input regarding legislative policy and priority development;
4. Respond to legislative calls-to-action by faxing, e-mailing or calling legislators on issues of importance;
5. Encourage participation in OSBA Convention and other association activities related to legislative liaisons.
