## **Student Fund-Raising Activities**

The Board of Education believes the primary education aims of the schools and the needs and interests of their students must be the most important consideration at all times. Fund-raising activities in general should not interfere with the operation of the regular course of study in classes, or require an employee to sacrifice time from the regularly planned program for students. All monies collected from such activities must go toward experiences which are closely allied to and in support of the instructional work of the school and which clearly advance the educational aims of the school.

While there is no intent to deny any worthwhile fund-raising activities, there is very definitely a desire to keep such activities within reasonable bounds. The following statements shall be a guide for determining participation in fund raising activities:

- 1. The primary educational aims of the schools and the needs and interests of their pupils must be a consideration at all times;
- 2. Schools shall not be used to promote private or commercial interests;
- 3. Schools shall not be used for direct sales promotion of individual competitive goods or services;
- 4. All materials or activities initiated by private sources shall be judge on grounds of their direct contribution to educational values, factual accuracy, and good taste;
- 5. Consideration shall be given, in all cases, to protecting students and staff against unreasonable added work and responsibilities.
